

Privacy Notice for Clinical Trials – Investigators, Potential Investigators, Site Staff, Members of Ethics Committees and Regulatory Boards, and Members of Data Monitoring Committees

Introduction

Kriya Therapeutics, Inc. ("Kriya") is committed to protecting the Personal Data we process for the purpose of selecting clinical trial sites and conducting clinical trials. This Privacy Notice sets forth the privacy principles and procedures and the technical security measures we apply to protect the Personal Data of:

- Clinical trial professionals including
 - Investigators and potential investigators
 - Staff at study sites
 - Member of ethics committees and regulatory boards
 - Members of data monitoring committees

Kriya complies with data protection laws and fulfills its regulatory responsibilities under applicable legislation and industry codes.

Scope

This Privacy Notice applies to Personal Data that is received and processed by Kriya in any format, including electronic and paper for the purposes of selecting clinical trial sites and conducting clinical trials. More information about the third-party organizations we engage to conduct trials can be found below.

Definitions

"Personal Data" means any information about an identifiable individual.

"Processing" means any operations or set of operations performed on Personal Data. It includes the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Data as defined in applicable privacy legislation.

Types of personal data processed

Kriya will process the following Personal Data:

- Location data – country, investigative site address
- Personal details – name, title, email address, address, phone number
- Professional qualifications where required such as National Provider Identifier Number, State, or other Medical License Number

Purpose of processing your personal data

Kriya will process your Personal Data to:

- Identify and evaluate prospective sites, investigators, and other site staff,
- Manage investigator and site staff,
- Administer and record payments to clinical trial sites or investigators in respect of services provided,
- Liaise with members of ethics and other regulatory committees relating to documentation and ethical approval,
- Meet our regulatory obligations under applicable laws and codes,
- Respond to your inquiries,
- Protect our legal rights or enforce agreements, and/or
- Administer our business, manage our relationship with you, and maintain quality standards.

Legal basis for processing Personal Data

Depending on the country or state laws that apply we will base the processing of your Personal Data on one of the following legal bases:

Contract – Processing is necessary for the performance of Kriya's agreement with you.

Legitimate Interest – Processing is necessary for Kriya's legitimate interest in ensuring the integrity and progress of our clinical research program. Where this is the legal basis, Kriya completes a Legitimate Interest Assessment to ensure that your rights and freedoms are not overridden by our interests.

Legal Obligation – Processing is required to comply with applicable laws and regulatory codes including obligations related to pharmacovigilance, safety reporting, and clinical trial records.

We do not use automated processing to make decisions while processing your Personal Data.

Use and Disclosure

Kriya undertakes to:

- Keep your Personal Data confidential and secure, and
- Use and disclose it for purposes that a reasonable person would consider appropriate in the circumstances, in compliance with applicable legislation.

Categories of third parties that Kriya engages for clinical trials include:

- Wholly owned subsidiaries of Kriya
- Contract research organizations
- Statistical research analysts
- Clinical advisors
- Technical providers for hosting and software services

The list of third parties that Kriya engages for a specific trial is available upon request.

Retention

Kriya is located in the United States of America and conducts global clinical trials. If your Personal Data is transferred internationally, it will be only for use by Kriya for the purposes described in this privacy statement. In each case, these transfers are subject to adequate safeguards as prescribed by law.

Kriya retains Personal Data from clinical trial professionals and instructs third parties to retain such Personal Data, depending on their role in the study, subject to applicable legislation.

Individual Access and Accuracy

Accessing, deleting, rectifying, and moving your Personal Data.

Depending on the country or state laws that apply to our processing of your Personal Data, you may have the right to:

- Access your Personal Data and have disclosed to you what Personal Data we have processed about you, and for what purposes,
- Object to our processing of your Personal Data where our collection and use is based on our legitimate interests,
- Require us to delete your Personal Data,
- Rectify any Personal Data we hold that is incorrect, and/or
- Have your Personal Data transmitted to another data controller.

If you want to exercise your rights related to your Personal Data, please let us know using the contact mechanisms identified below. We may ask you to provide sufficient information to verify and complete your request. Subject to the rights you have, and to any legal or other requirements, we will complete your request within thirty (30) calendar days.

Security Measures

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational security measures to protect your Personal Data against unintentional, unauthorized or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, disclosure, access, and any other unintentional, unauthorized or unlawful forms of processing under applicable law.
